oriented society of the present time if formal education really means to become meaningful and aims at qualitative improvement. Active participation and periodic meetings of library advisory committee, involvement of the librarian in academic activities, participation of the users, support from the management, regular flow of resource generation, skilled and qualified staff, capacity building in terms of information and communication technology are few areas where best practices can be adopted.
